



Academic Integration Mini Grant 2009-2010

The purpose of this grant is to encourage collaboration between Career and Technical Education (CTE) teachers at the secondary level with academic practitioners at the high schools and/or post-secondary teachers, which results in useable lesson plans.

Grants following the criteria below will be given serious consideration for funding:

SCOPE AND PURPOSE

PURPOSE: Curriculum Development - teamed with an academic teacher/specialist from your school/district **OR** a post-secondary teacher (academic or CTE teacher) develop a method to integrate mathematics or reading or writing, or science skills/standards into a specific CTE lesson plan.

DELIVERABLE: At least one high school level CTE lesson plan per CTE team member integrating math, reading, writing and/or science AZ standards into each lesson plan. Plans should demonstrate academic skills or strategies that can be implemented at your school in a CTE program area to develop a collaborative teaching style as well as demonstrate how the standards can be taught within the lesson plan. Lessons will be submitted electronically in the format we will provide you.

TEAM PROFILE

1. Minimum two person team - Maximum 4 person team.
2. CTE teacher(s) will be the leads in this project.
3. Lessons are to be **CTE lessons** integrating academic areas.
4. At least one member of the team must have attended or agree to attend an East Valley Consortium academic integration workshop.
5. At least one academic teacher or post-secondary teacher.
6. Project description outlined in completed application form.
7. Approval from your principal and District CTE Director.
8. First time applications will be given priority.

Only projects reflecting the scope/purpose above and team profile listed will be considered for funding.

PROJECT APPLICATIONS ARE DUE TO THE EAST VALLEY TECH PREP OFFICE BY 4PM, Tuesday, September 22, 2009. You may email, U.S.mail or fax your completed project application to the East Valley Consortium Office.

Projects accepted for funding will be notified by email with Orientation Meeting details. The project Orientation Meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 30.

FUNDING

Stipend for completion of lesson plans (one stipend paid per teacher)

The lesson plans will be submitted using the template you will be provided at the orientation meeting

Orientation Meeting Stipend (September 30)

\$50.00

End of Year Meeting Stipend (May 5)

\$50.00

Performance for stipends is to be outside of contracted hours with teacher's District.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Required Meetings:

1. **ORIENTATION:** All team members must plan on attending an orientation meeting. This meeting will present the East Valley Tech Prep preferred lesson plan outline as well as answer any initial questions your group may have prior to starting the project activities.

The Orientation Meeting is scheduled for:

Wednesday, September 30, from 4:00-5:30 pm (you will be notified of location with project funding approval information)

All team members will need to attend. Teams will be asked summarize their project outcomes at that meeting.

2. **End of the Year Meeting.** The last meeting for the teachers representing the East Valley Consortium is **Wednesday, May 5, 2007.** Integration Teams will be asked to briefly summarize their projects.
3. **Academic Integration Workshops.** It is highly recommended that at least one member of the team have previously attended or be scheduled to attend one of the East Valley Academic Integration Workshops. Please contact the Tech Prep Office for workshop dates and registration information.
